NORMANDY TRIP MONDAY 12-FRIDAY 16 JULY

Dear Parents,

I am pleased to be able to give you information concerning the Year 8 trip to Normandy. For the fourth consecutive year, we are running the trip in conjunction with Schools into Europe and it promises to be another entertaining and educational week. Pupils will spend four nights (half board accommodation) at the Hotel Kyriad Carentan (www.hotelcarentan.com) and enjoy a number of day trips from this base. Excursions will include time at the Landing Beaches, a visit to The Bayeux Tapestry, a visit to The D Day Museum, time in the city of Caen, a visit to Arromanches 360 cinema and The Pegasus Memorial, a visit to a goat cheese farm and time in Deauville and Honfleur en route. Pupils will therefore have the opportunity of not only experiencing French culture and practising language skills but also furthering their historical awareness.

The total price of 334 pounds includes comprehensive travel insurance, the cost of a collective passport, executive touring coach and Dover-Calais ferry crossings. Pupils will need to take a small amount of money (euros cash) for lunches and spending money but all other costs are included. The trip usually leaves at midnight on the Sunday/Monday and returns late on Friday night. I will provide more detailed information concerning the exact itinerary, what to take and collective passport arrangements nearer the time. In the meantime, it is necessary to secure a provisional booking for which a deposit of 70 pounds is necessary, no later than October 19th. Please complete and detach the slip below, and place it with a cheque (payable to Boroughbridge High School) in an envelope marked with 'Normandy' and the name of the pupil. The envelope should then be placed in the box by reception. There is a maximum number of 40 pupils able to go on the trip. We will pick names out of a hat in the event of the trip being over subscribed. The remainder of the money (264 pounds) will be required by 15th March.
